Prayer & Cranes! This Lent, we invite you to take part in a creative, hands-on prayer practice. Stop by the narthex to write a prayer on a piece of origami paper and fold it into a crane. If folding isn't your thing, you're welcome to place your prayer in the basket provided. The completed cranes will be displayed in the sanctuary as a visual expression of our shared prayers.

Care Kit Collection: This Lent, we are supporting Lutheran World Relief by collecting care kits for people facing hardship around the world. These kits provide essential items that bring comfort, dignity, and hope to individuals and families during times of crisis. The kits will be collected Sunday, March 1 and Sunday, March 8.
