Why are we changing to a 9:00 AM service time from May 3 through the summer?

The move to a 9:00 AM service allows us to better utilize the broader Willow Park Church network to support the Lake Country campus. It creates space for Pastor Phil and Pastor Glen to preach throughout the summer and enables additional staff to invest in the ministry. This season will help strengthen the campus as we prepare for new leadership and shape the future mission.

Is this change permanent?

No. The 9:00 AM service time is proposed for May through August and will be reviewed. Any long-term decision will depend in part on the progress of our pastoral search.

Where are we in the pastoral search?

We are currently receiving applications and interviewing a number of candidates. As you can appreciate, this is a careful and thorough process. We will continue to keep the congregation updated weekly as we move through May, June, and the summer.

Why are we changing our name to Willow Park Church Lake Country?

We believe a clear and strong identity is important. “Willow Park Church Lake Country” helps people easily recognize where the campus is located and invites the community to be part of what God is doing here.

What does it mean that we are “re-launching” the campus?

A re-launch is an intentional moment to reintroduce the campus to the community. It’s an opportunity to build momentum, renew vision, and clearly communicate who we are and where we’re going as a church.

When will the official re-launch take place?

The re-launch is planned for **Sunday, September 13** (time to be confirmed). More details will be shared as we spend the summer preparing, praying, and discerning how the Holy Spirit is leading us into this next season.
