Psalm 136 repeats one phrase twenty-six times – once per verse. Do you remember the phrase? “His love endures forever.” The word translated as “love” is my favorite Hebrew word: **chesed**. It points to God’s steadfast lovingkindness and gracious covenant loyalty toward His people. It’s an amazing word that describes all that God has done for us. So, Psalm 136 repeats the phrase “His love endures forever” over and over as it recounts God’s redemptive history.

In a similar way, every time I consider the history of First Presbyterian Church Fresno, I find myself repeating that same phrase, “His love endures forever.” Surely, it’s been God’s covenant faithfulness to us that has kept us, protected us, held us, directed us, empowered us, provided for us, chastened us, nurtured us, and used us. I pray that as you consider all that God did in us and through us in this last year, 2025, you will also join the Psalmist in repeating, “His love endures forever.” May we indeed, “Give thanks to the LORD, for He is good. His love endures forever.” (Psalm 136:1)

Once again, we have provided two particular reminders of God’s faithfulness to us. The first is what you are reading now. It’s our 2025 Snapshot which includes both some highlights of the last year and information for our congregational meeting on Super Sunday, February 8, 2026. SLATE OF NOMINEES FOR NOMINATING COMMITTEE



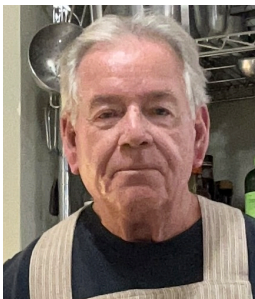
JIM COUSINS, NOMINATING COMMITTEE

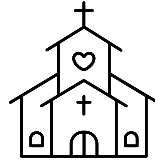
