Grief Group

To love deeply means we will grieve deeply.

No matter what the circumstances, grief is a painful, confusing process. Each journey of grief is different and uniquely yours. Our Congregational Care ministry is excited to offer a safe space for those grieving to share their journey and heal together in a place where people understand the difficult emotions of grief.

Grief Share, a 13-week grief support group, will take place on Sunday afternoons, from 3:30-4:30 in Room 165 (behind the main kitchen). We recommend parking in the Burdeshaw parking lot. Your hosts will be, myself, Rev. Liz Hinton, Pastor of Congregational Care, and long-time church member, Libby Krietemeyer, who brings her personal experience of walking through grief following the death of her husband.

As we embark on this journey with you, we will use Grief Share curriculum to guide our time together. We will discuss what is typical and what to expect in the days ahead. Since there are no neat, orderly stages of grief, you'll learn helpful ways of coping, in all its unpredictability. You will also expand your community of support along the way.

Each week will feature insights from counselors, pastors, and healthcare professionals on grief-related topics. Along with honest, relatable stories—such as navigating the "grief fog" like accidentally arriving at work with two different shoes on—as gentle reminders that you are not alone on this journey.

There will be opportunities to share in small group discussions, and you will receive a book to help you navigate your own personally-lived daily experience at home. Some topics we will talk about are managing emotions like loneliness, anxiety, sadness, anger, and regret.
