

After receiving a vision from the Lord, David and Lydia Martinez obediently sold everything they owned and moved to Honduras to follow God's will in providing for abandoned and unwanted children. There they founded Orphanage Emmanuel in December 1989. Without electricity and running water, Emmanuel opened its doors for the first five children, and Emmanuel has continued to grow ever since. Emmanuel now houses and cares for over 250 unwanted, abandoned, and abused children of all ages. It is located approximately 70 miles northeast of Honduras' capital, Tegucigalpa. Emmanuel's facilities include a church and homes for the children, staff, and volunteers. It also features dining halls, laundry facilities, a warehouse, bakery, medical and dental clinics, soccer field, and gymnasium. Emmanuel is a Christian ministry whose vision is to evangelize and disciple children so that they may grow to be living lights and good examples in the ways of God to their countrymen.

Our church has been sending Christmas gifts to the Orphanage since the Fall of 2020, as we "adopt" boys and girls from the Orphanage to purchase the only Christmas gifts they will receive.




