- 1. Praying we are people who hear and do.

- 3. Praying we don't turn back to old desires.
 - "Holy Spirit we ask that You do Your great work in our lives. Convict us when
 we turn back toward the things that we have been delivered from. May we
 never refuse to hear the Word of God. Help us to be faithful in serving the
 Lord our God and not our own selfish desires."
