God's Admonition to a Nation

Prayer is communication with Supernatural Expectations.

This week's key passages. **Ezekiel 18:30-32**

1. Praying we repent. An act of the mind and the mouth
 - “Father as a nation we have strayed so far from where we began. We have drifted from You and what You long for us to be. We intend to make a conscious decision to repent from the evils that we as a nation have done. We ask that You forgive our personal sins and the sins of our nation. We know that You will hear our confession and forgive our sin.” **Ezekiel 18:30**

2. Praying we turn from our sin. An act of the will and the body
 - “Lord we know that turning from our sin is an integral part of repentance. Jesus we purpose to do more than just say we repent; we will turn from the things that have drawn us away from You and turn toward righteousness. We realize that if we fail to turn from our iniquity it will lead to our ruin. We surrender our bodies as living sacrifices to You so that we can reveal Your perfect will” **Ezekiel 18:30**

3. Praying we cast away transgression. An act of the emotions and spirit
 - “Heavenly Father help us to cast off the things that have caused us to be distant from You. May sin and iniquity be so repulsive to us that we can't tolerate them any longer. May we not only distance ourselves from them but may we openly take a stand against evil all around us. May our spirit move us to take a stand against evil and the evil one.” **Ezekiel 18:31**

4. Praying we have a new heart and a new spirit. An act of God in our lives
 - “Lord Jesus we want You to give us a new heart and a new spirit. Direct our hearts to fully follow You. We ask that You give us the desires that are in our hearts because we want our desires to be Your desires. Lord make our spirit new through the Holy Spirit. We want the Holy Spirit of God to lead us to a life of righteousness and holiness. Jesus renew us from the inside out.” **Ezekiel 18:31**
