1. Who is He?

A definition of king:

The supreme and sovereign ruler with ultimate, absolute, legitimate authority, backed by the actual right and the power to manifest his will, intent, and influence over the realm of his kingdom.



1 Timothy 6:12-14

“...when you made your good confession in the presence of many witnesses. In the sight of God, who gives life to everything, and of Christ Jesus, who while testifying before Pontius Pilate made the good confession...”

2. What's He Like?

Philippians 2:7-11

“Instead, he gave up his divine privileges... Therefore, God elevated him to the place of highest honor and gave him the name above all other names...”

“...He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come. And He put all things under His feet, and gave Him to be head over all things to the church, which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all.”

3. How Does this Affect Me?

1 Samuel 16:1, 13

*For I have **provided Myself a king** among his sons... Then Samuel took the horn of oil and anointed him in the midst of his brothers; and the Spirit of the Lord came upon David **from that day forward.**"*

2 Samuel 5:1-4 Then all the tribes of Israel came to David at Hebron and spoke, saying...in time past... you were the one who led Israel out and brought them in; and the Lord said to you, ‘You shall shepherd My people Israel, and be ruler over Israel.’”
Therefore all the elders of Israel came to the king at Hebron...and they anointed David king over Israel.
