Dear *Church,*

As we enter the summer rhythm of the church, I enter with back-to-back trips. As you read this, our team of 13 is on the ground in Kenya, carrying your prayers and your sending spirit with them. I'll be back in the pulpit on June 14th – then flying almost immediately to Jacksonville, Florida, for the Cooperative Baptist Fellowship (CBF) General Assembly. (Maybe this will guarantee a shorter sermon!)

CBF is a fellowship of Baptist Christians formed in the early 1990s around a simple conviction: that Baptists are at their best when every believer is free to engage Scripture, follow the Spirit, and serve without top-down control. For many of us who grew up in the broader Baptist tradition, CBF became not a departure from our Baptist identity, but a recovery of it – making room for women in ministry, staying committed to global missions through cooperation, and renewing our commitment to the four fragile freedoms of Bible freedom, soul freedom (freedom of conscience), church freedom, and religious freedom.

This past year, I've had the honor of serving on the CBF Governing Board. At the General Assembly in Florida, I will have the honor of being nominated as Moderator-Elect, a servant leadership role representing thousands of Baptists in the Fellowship. By saying yes, I am committed to three more years of faithful service as Moderator-Elect in 2026-2027, Moderator in 2027-2028, and Past Moderator in 2028-2029.

I don't take this lightly. Whatever I carry into Jacksonville and the years to come, I carry from this church.

Please pray for our Kenya team and partners, for safe travels, and for the Assembly and the future of both CBF and FBC JC - for the glory of God and the good of the world.

FOOD 4 KIDS

Help provide nutritious and delicious lunches for children on summer break.

For nearly twenty years, First Baptist Church has teamed with **Food 4 Kids**, a program that helps fill the gap during the summer months when school lunches are unavailable. Sack lunches are prepared and distributed throughout the community for children who might otherwise go hungry.

Food insecurity has reached a 10-year high in Missouri. The Food Bank for Central and Northeast Missouri reported record demand, driven in part by national safety-net interruptions and government shutdowns. It is estimated that one in five Missouri children experiences hunger.

Thousands of children in Central Missouri rely on free and reduced-price school lunches, but during the summer, it can be tough to access nutritious food. The Food Bank works with partner agencies to fill the gaps. That means all kids can focus on the important work of learning, playing, and growing. Studies show children who face food insecurity are more likely to experience anxiety, irritability, more problems at school, and at home.

Once again, First Baptist Church will be joining the fight against hunger by participating in Food 4 Kids this summer. We'll be providing kid-friendly, nutritious lunches and snacks to children during the summer months when school is not in session.

First Baptist Church volunteers are needed for the week of August 3-7.

- Three to four volunteers are needed each day from 10:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. to prepare and pack lunches. First Presbyterian Church in Jefferson City is the food prep and pickup center.
- Four delivery teams are needed to deliver meals to four locations. A two-person delivery team consists of one driver and one helper to assist with distribution. Teams pick up lunches and snacks around 11:45 a.m. and return by 1:00 p.m. (or earlier if all lunches have been distributed.)

Volunteers may sign up for one day, multiple days, or the entire week. Please consider giving an hour or a few hours to this worthwhile endeavor.
