5. What is the covenant significance of Abraham’s land purchase? What does it reveal about his faith in God’s promises?
6. Why does the author repeat the terms of the transaction at the end of the chapter (vs 17-20)?
7. How does Hebrews 11:8-16 help interpret Genesis 24? What is this “city that has foundations, whose designer and builder is God” (Heb 11:10, ESV), and what does it mean to “greet” or “salute” the promises of God from afar (Heb 11:13)?
