

# The Bookmark Reading Plan

Put a bookmark in only two books at a time—one OT and one NT. Move through readings from left to right (e.g., Matthew, Hebrews & James, Romans, Mark, etc.). During personal devotions, read one chapter/section from each testament, or alternate between OT and NT each time.

**Notes:** The Twelve are the Minor Prophets (Hosea–Malachi), and the Five Megillot (“Scrolls”) are Song of Songs, Ruth, Lamentations, Ecclesiastes, and Esther. After the final reading on the fourth line (Daniel–Nehemiah), read Proverbs before returning to Genesis. You may skim repetitive lists, focusing on the text’s point rather than verbatim readings.
