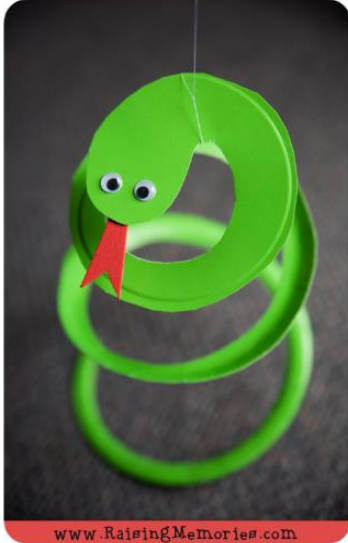

Paper Plate Snake Puppet Craft

Here's a craft your kids can play with when they've finished making it! This cute little snake was made from a paper plate and a few simple household and craft supplies. It was simple to make and easy to involve my kids with so I thought it'd be a good one to share here!



Here's what you need for this project:

Paper Plate
2 Googly Eyes
Glue & Tape
Red Construction paper or sheet of foam
Marker
String

Start by drawing the shape of your snake on the back of the paper plate. Basically, your aim is to get the shape of your snake's head in the middle and then coil it's body around it, like this:



We actually made this craft several years ago and I found the photos recently, realizing I hadn't blogged about it. If you follow me on [Instagram](#) and are familiar with my kids, you'll know Talia looks much younger in this photo of her cutting out the plate!

Once you've cut out your snake, you can cut out a snake tongue from construction paper or foam and tape it to the bottom of your snake head:



Glue the googly eyes onto the snake's head and tie a string around the top of the neck (to hang it for display or to carry it around and play with it like a puppet!).

(Noah's wife disappears, Dove appears)

Dove: Cooooooo, Coooooo, Coooooo.

Noah: Dove, I am going to send you out to see if the flood waters have receded.

(Dove disappears, delay for a few moments, then Dove reappears)

Noah: Dove, I see you could find no place to land and have returned to the ark.

Dove: Cooooo, coooooo, coooooo.

Noah: Dove, I am going to send you out again to see if the flood waters have receded

(Dove disappears, delays for a moment, then Dove reappears with an olive leaf in mouth)

Dove: Cooooo, cooooo, coooo.

Noah: Dove, I see you found an olive leaf, the flood waters have receded.

(Dove disappears)

God: Noah:

Noah: Yes God.

God: Noah, come out of the ark, you and your wife and your sons and their wives and bring out every kind of living creature that is with you, so they can multiply on the earth and be fruitful and increase in number on it.

Noah: Yes God we will come out of the ark.

(Noah's wife appears)

Noah's wife: Noah, what are you building ?

Noah: I am building an alter to sacrifice animals to God.

(Noah's wife disappears)

God: Noah, the aroma of your sacrifice is pleasing to me, never again will all life be destroyed by the waters of a flood.
