Six Ways Satan Attacks Your Children By Brad Harrub (Adapted and edited for length)

We don't have to spend much time proving that Satan is winning too many battles with our young people. You can see it in the culture all around us. The real question is: how is he doing it?

First, Satan has wrapped apathy and spiritual laziness in attractive packaging. Many Christian families simply aren't pursuing truth the way they should. Parents often stop paying attention to what their children are learning or what media is shaping their thinking. As Hosea warned long ago, "My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge" (Hosea 4:6).

Second, many families have been convinced that there's no real need to prepare for spiritual battle. Yet Paul told Christians to put on the whole armor of God so they can stand when evil comes (Ephesians 6:13-17). We have to ask ourselves honestly: are our children equipped?

Third, Satan works to capture the mind. Jesus said we are to love God with all our heart, soul, and mind (Matthew 22:37-38). But if our children's minds are constantly filled with voices that oppose God, that love becomes harder to grow.

Fourth, some families act as if spiritual training only happens at church. But real faith is built daily in the home through consistent teaching and example.

Fifth, many today have embraced a smaller picture of God—one that talks about love but forgets His holiness and righteousness. Scripture reminds us that sin separates us from Him (Isaiah 59:2).

Sixth, Satan confuses our priorities, pushing us toward comfort and material success. Yet Jesus warned, "You cannot serve God and mammon" (Matthew 6:24).

The battle is real. And every Christian home must decide what Joshua declared long ago: "But as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord" (Joshua 24:15).
