Revival Starts with a Change of Priorities by T. Ritter

Revival isn't just about a moment in church—it's about a transformation in our daily lives. Many of us long for a deeper connection with God, but we often let the distractions of life take priority over our spiritual growth. True revival begins when we make God our first priority.

2 Corinthians 5:17 reminds us, "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation. The old has passed away; behold, the new has come." Revival means letting go of complacency, stepping out of our comfort zones, and embracing the new things God wants to do in our lives.

Often, fear and uncertainty hold us back from experiencing a renewed relationship with God.
