A Simple Conversation Over Coffee

This morning at Wawa, I had a good reminder of how simple evangelism can be when we make it natural.

Our conversation turned to church when he asked me how my Spanish was so strong. I told him that our church helped me with that. He told me it was very interesting and seemed genuinely interested in possibly coming.

The door that was opened at the coffee station continued when we got to our cars. He rolled down his window and specifically asked me more about the church. I got his contact information and sent him our website, service times, and an invitation.

That moment — realizing we were parked right next to each other — showed me God was clearly at work.

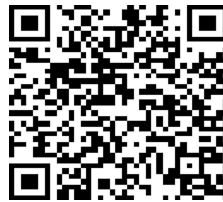
