“Why Me?”

I remember talking to a young mother whose child had just been diagnosed with a rare illness. Through tears, she asked, “Why me?” It is a question born out of pain, confusion, and the feeling of being overwhelmed. And maybe you’ve asked it too.

When the layoff hits, when the loved one dies, when the diagnosis has your name on it we want to know WHY. Why not someone else? Why now?

In John 9, Jesus’ disciples pointed to a blind man and asked, “Who sinned, this man or his parents?” But Jesus said, “Neither... this happened so that the works of God might be displayed in him.”

Sometimes the “why me” moments are actually “watch Me” moments—God saying, Watch Me carry you. Watch Me heal you. Watch Me use this pain to bring purpose.

You may not understand it now, but I encourage you to trust him because your story isn’t over. God may not be punishing you but positioning you for something greater.

So, if you’re asking “Why me?”, don’t stop there. Follow it with, “Use me.” God turns our hardest questions into His most powerful answers.
