Amazing Grace — The Gift We Can't Ignore

Amazing Grace is a song we love to sing, but sadly, it's a topic we often avoid—perhaps out of fear that it might be taken as a license to sin (Romans 6:1). But we can't afford to overlook it. Grace is not a loophole—it's the very heart of the gospel.

The apostle Paul reminds us, *“For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God”* (Ephesians 2:8). We rightly emphasize obedience—baptism (Acts 2:38), faithful living (Revelation 2:10), and walking in the light (1 John 1:7). But none of that is possible—or even meaningful—without grace.

Grace is God reaching down to us while we were still sinners (Romans 5:8). It's the Father running to embrace the prodigal son while he still smelled like the pigpen (Luke 15:20). It's the blood of Jesus that cleanses us—not just once, but continually—as we walk in the light (1 John 1:7).

Grace doesn't mean we stop trying—it means we can't earn salvation. We can't save ourselves, but grace gives us the strength to obey. As Paul said, *“By the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me was not in vain”* (1 Corinthians 15:10).

We must preach grace boldly—not as a footnote, but as the foundation. Grace doesn't water down obedience; it fuels it. Baptism, repentance, and holy living aren't optional—but without grace, they're impossible. Without grace, we're lost. With grace, nothing is beyond God's reach. Let us be a people of grace and truth (John 1:17), standing firm in both.
