



We reach people who have never heard through missionaries, church planting, disciple-making, Bible translation, compassion ministries, and workers serving among unreached peoples. We strengthen the Church in our cities and beyond through ministry expansion, outreach partnerships, and initiatives that extend the Church into everyday spaces. We raise up future Christian leaders through scholarships, internships, ministry training, and leadership development so the Gospel does not stop with us but multiplies through the next generation.

# OUR DECADE OF SENDING

**A Vision to Send**  
Every church reaches moments when God invites them into something bigger than they planned, budgeted, or felt ready for. Moments that stretch faith and redefine obedience.

Journey 100 is one of those moments.

We believe God is calling Journey Church to send **100 missionaries from our church to the nations by the year 2033**. One hundred sons and daughters raised here, disciples here, prayed over here, and sent from here to carry the name of Jesus to places where He is not yet known.

*This is not a program. It is a calling.*

## From Supporting to Sending

Journey has always cared deeply about missions. We have prayed, given, partnered, and gone on short-term trips. And that matters. But God is inviting us into something more.

There is a difference between being a church that supports missionaries and becoming a sending church. Supporting helps from a distance. Sending releases our best and takes responsibility. Journey 100 is about becoming that kind of church.

## Why 100?

Because nearly 42% of the world remains unreached. Billions of people still have little to no access to the Gospel. Entire cities and people groups have never heard the name of Jesus.

We believe God can change that in our lifetime. Not all at once, but step by step. Journey 100 is our faith response to that reality.

## Who Will Go?

The largest generation on the planet today is Gen Z. In many unreached nations, they make up the majority of the population.

And the future missionaries to those nations are already among us. They are in Journey Kids and Journey Youth. They are in our homes, our small groups, and our campuses. They are at SEU Journey and Christian Life School. Maybe it is your child. Maybe it is someone you know. *Maybe it is you.*

## A Sending Church Changes History

In Acts 13, a local church prayed and fasted, and the Holy Spirit said, "Set apart for me Barnabas and Saul." One sending moment in a local church changed the world.

We believe God still works that way. The next Paul, Lydia, or Timothy may already be here, waiting to be seen, disciplesd, and sent.

## This Is Who We Are Becoming

The local church is the sending base for the mission of God. We do not just fund missions. We raise missionaries. We send our best, not our leftovers, and we take responsibility to cover those we send with prayer, generosity, and care.

So far, *14* of the *100* Journey missionaries have already been sent.

Each one was commissioned with a numbered token, marking their place in the Journey 100 story. There are more to come.

# Impact | *Pray*

## BRIAN & BETH HACKBARTH



Through years of prayer and personal involvement in missions, they have witnessed countless answered prayers. They've seen churches built, lives transformed, and physical healings take place. One of the most profound moments was deeply personal—the miraculous healing of their son-in-law, Liviu Ghigeanu, a missionary serving in Romania. God intervened in a life-threatening kidney condition, performing what they describe as a life-saving miracle and a powerful reminder of God's faithfulness.



**B**eth and Brian's passion for praying for missions began long before they ever shared that calling together. For Beth, it started as a new believer when she was invited on a mission trip to Haiti. For Brian, it began in childhood, listening to missionaries share stories in church. His family often hosted missionaries in their home, and hearing firsthand about their needs compelled him to pray. Over time, their individual journeys formed a shared commitment to stand in prayer for Kingdom Builder partners around the world.

At the core of every prayer is their greatest hope: to see souls saved and lives transformed by the gospel. They pray for God's love, protection, and encouragement to surround every Kingdom Builder partner, and they intentionally pray against discouragement when the work becomes difficult or overwhelming.



Their prayers are intentional and rooted in Scripture. They regularly pray for protection over missionaries and their families, and they ask God to open doors that no one can shut, holding tightly to the promise of Revelation 3:7–8. They also pray for provision—that financial support would come in, commitments would be honored, and God would bless those who give faithfully. For Beth and Brian, prayer is not passive support; it is active participation in God's work.

Praying for missions has also shaped their own faith. They have seen that God transforms not only those being served, but also those who pray and those who go. With firsthand experience of the strongholds God is breaking around the world, Beth and Brian remain committed to standing in the gap—trusting that every prayer plays a vital role in advancing God's Kingdom.

# Impact | Give

## LIAM JACKSON

In the fall of 2025, Journey Kids introduced their Kingdom Builder initiative: Africa's Children and Teens—an organization dedicated to meeting the spiritual and physical needs of Africa's next generation by resourcing and training local churches. With faith and excitement, Journey Kids set an ambitious goal: to raise \$8,000 to help make an eternal impact.

One of the people who took that goal to heart was Liam, a 10-year-old with a big faith and a love for baseball.

After hearing about Africa's Children and Teens, Liam sat down with his mom and dad to think about how he could help. Instead of doing something ordinary, Liam asked a simple question: What do I love, and how can God use it? The answer came quickly—baseball.

Liam is a pitcher in Little League, and for him, the mound is a place of focus, discipline, and joy. Together with his parents, he came up with a creative idea: he would ask friends and family to pledge a dollar amount for every strikeout he recorded during his fall season. Every pitch would become an opportunity to give.



As the season unfolded, Liam didn't just play hard—he pitched with purpose. By the final game, he had racked up an impressive 41 strikeouts. Thanks to the generosity of those who pledged and the faithfulness behind each throw, Liam raised \$1,051 for Kingdom Builders.

When asked why this mattered so much to him, Liam shared simply and sincerely,

# Impact | Go

## TAMMY CONFORTI



While the entire trip left a deep impact, one moment stands above the rest. A young girl named Duwana was brought to the team with a severe burn covering her hand and forearm. The pain was evident, yet she endured it silently. With limited medical resources available, the team did what they could—cleaning the wound, offering food, comfort, and prayer. Sitting beside Duwana, she gently connected with her through a simple game and a shared smile, even across a language barrier.



It began during a Sunday service when a video shared stories of past Kingdom Builder trips and highlighted the vast number of unreached people groups around the world. As images of God's people in hard-to-reach places filled the screen, tears streamed down her face. In that moment, Tammy felt the unmistakable tug of the Holy Spirit. Turning to her friend, she could only say four words: ***"I'm going to go."*** She didn't yet know where—but she knew she was saying yes.

That yes soon led Tammy to Tanzania, where she joined a small team serving in a remote village in the African bush. Drawing from nearly twenty years of experience teaching preschool and special needs children, she knew immediately she was being called to help teach Vacation Bible School. The team focused on sharing four simple but life-changing truths: God is loving, faithful, forgiving, and holy. They lived simply—camping near a primary school and worshiping in a handmade church where the presence of the Holy Spirit felt tangible and alive.

The next morning, the team gathered at dawn to pray for healing. They prayed boldly—for mercy, protection, and complete restoration. Weeks later, after returning home, she received a photo of Duwana. Her arm was fully healed, marked only by a faint scar. It was a moment of overwhelming joy and a powerful reminder: God still performs miracles.

Witnessing the faith of the Datooga people forever changed Tammy's perspective. Despite harsh daily realities, their joyful worship and deep trust in God as Provider, Protector, and Healer revealed a profound, childlike faith. That experience ignited her heart and deepened her obedience to Christ's call to "go and make disciples."

Her prayer now is simple—that others would listen when God stirs their hearts. *Sometimes, all it takes is one yes to see God move in ways you never imagined.*



# Impact | *Send*

## ALLIA BEKKERS

For much of her life, serving on the mission field was not something Allia had envisioned. Before 2024, overseas missions were not on her radar. That perspective began to change after participating in several short-term Kingdom Builder trips. Through those experiences, a quiet but steady shift took place. Rather than one defining moment, it was a collection of small, Spirit-led moments that stirred her heart. As she spent time in prayer and discernment, clarity came: *stepping into missions was the next right step of obedience.*

She is preparing to serve in Siem Reap, Cambodia, a place that deeply impacted her during a previous Kingdom Builder trip. Cambodia's history is marked by turmoil, false worship, and spiritual brokenness, resulting in a widespread lack of hope. What stood out most was how few people have ever heard the Gospel. The question became unavoidable: if people have never been introduced to the hope found in Jesus, how can they be expected to live differently? That realization solidified her sense of calling and affirmed Cambodia as the place she was meant to serve.



Her ministry will focus on children and young adults, from primary-age students through university students. Through teaching English, serving within the local church, and intentionally building relationships, she hopes to meet people where they are and walk alongside them. This work builds on nearly a decade of experience serving kids and youth in the United States. While the cultural context will be new, ministering to this age demographic provides a familiar and meaningful starting point. She will also support existing Kingdom Builder partners in Cambodia, joining in the work God is already doing through established ministries.



Looking toward the future, her vision extends far beyond short-term impact. The long-term hope is to see families experience lasting change through Christ. Conversations with students could shape the way they engage with their faith and, in turn, influence their families for generations. That ripple effect is what makes this calling so compelling.



How can we be praying ?

**Peace, wisdom, and boldness** as she prepares for and begins ministry in Cambodia.  
**Open hearts** among children, students, and families to receive the Gospel.  
**Strong relationships** built through teaching, church involvement, and daily life.  
**Lasting fruit**, with lives and family trajectories changed for generations through Christ.





# Pierce and Meghan Davis

## THAILAND

Pierce and Meghan Davis serve as missionaries in Thailand, focusing on unreached people groups—communities with no churches and little to no Christian presence. Their call to Thailand began as they learned about the global imbalance of gospel access. In countries with large Christian populations, there are roughly 187 missionaries per one million Christians. Among Hindu and Buddhist populations, the number drops to just four per million. These statistics clarified their calling to serve in a predominantly Buddhist nation where millions have never heard the gospel.

The Davises intentionally plant churches in places where the local church does not yet exist. Their ministry is rooted in the belief that the local church is God's primary means of transformation. Having experienced life change through the church themselves, they are committed to bringing that same hope to communities that have never had access to it.

Their work is grounded in incarnational living. Pierce and Meghan live in close community with those they serve, structuring their family life to support long-term presence and meaningful relationships. They homeschool their children so they can remain deeply embedded in their neighborhood and practice what

they describe as “near-neighbor witness.” Ministry is woven into daily life as they walk alongside people who do not yet know Christ.

A key focus of their work is discipleship and leadership development. Early on, Pierce realized the need was too vast for one family alone. Instead of trying to do everything themselves, they invited young leaders to walk with them, mentoring and empowering them to step into responsibility. Today, these emerging leaders help launch new churches and ministries where local believers are equipped to reach their own people.

The Davises' ministry also includes campus outreach, school programs in unreached communities, and community development in impoverished areas. Together with the national church, they are pursuing a vision to plant 100 churches across Thailand by 2033. As of now, 26 churches have been planted, with seven more preparing to launch in 2026.

One example of God's work can be seen in a village outside Bangkok, where a house church meets in the home of a Buddhist woman. Her son, Phinyo—whom Pierce has been discipling—now co-leads the group and has opened both his family's home and village to the gospel. Although his mother

initially resisted Christianity, Christ's presence steadily grew in her home. Months later, she offered a newly renovated room for church use, even arranging improvements. What began as resistance became an open door for ministry.

Looking ahead, Pierce and Meghan plan to launch a discipleship and training school in 2026. The school will provide hands-on ministry training, equipping young leaders to serve in unreached and under-reached communities. Pierce is also partnering with the Romanian Pentecostal Movement to bring international missionaries into Thailand, reflecting a global Church united in one mission.

When asked about their desired legacy, the Davises point to Galatians 1:24: “And they glorified God because of me.”

They hope King Jesus would receive the glory as the gospel advances and churches take root where it has never existed before. They invite the church back home to partner through prayer, sending, and faithful support—joining in the story God is writing across Thailand.

How can we

**Unreached communities:** Pray for openness to the gospel and new churches to grow.  
**Emerging leaders:** Pray for faith, courage, and effectiveness in ministry.  
**Pierce and Meghan:** Pray for wisdom, endurance, and guidance in their work.  
**Training school 2026:** Pray God raises laborers to multiply gospel impact.

A Wisconsin-based initiative bringing shoes and the love of Christ to Africa





### **Pray for the Laborers**


Pray that God strengthens and empowers His workers—past, present, and future—as they serve with humility and unity, proclaiming the Gospel with compassion and truth.

**A**t Journey Church, short-term global ministry teams are not trips— they're discipleship environments designed to form people into Jesus-shaped, mission-minded followers. We go because God is already at work among the nations, and He invites us to participate in what He's doing.

***We go to align our hearts with God's heart.***

God's heart beats for people who have never heard the name of Jesus. When Journeyers step into other cultures, we see what God sees and feel what He feels—His love for the nations becomes personal.

***We go to strengthen and serve our global partners.***

Our teams do not replace the work of global workers—they reinforce it. We go to encourage, honor, and accelerate the ministry of those serving long-term on the front lines.

***We go to deepen discipleship in every Journeyer.***

Teams stretch us. They shape character, humility, and compassion. They move faith from "I know" to "I've seen, I've served, I've participated." Short-term teams help people discover their gifts, calling, and part in God's mission.

***We go to expand gospel access.***

In many places, our presence opens doors for relationship that our partners continue long after we leave. Teams create touchpoints that move ministries forward, especially in unreached and unengaged areas.

***We go because saying yes changes lives.***


