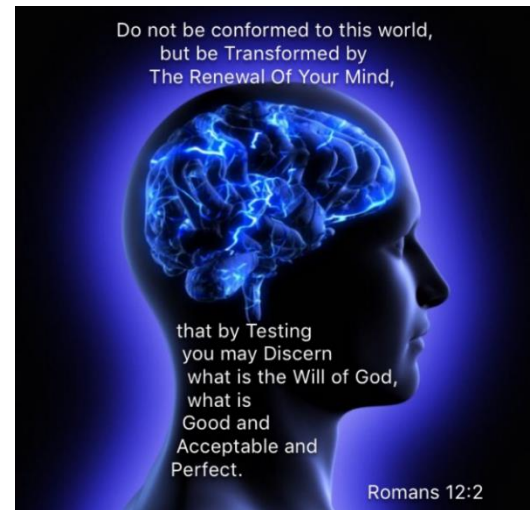
Brotherhood - Deep Connection Through Shared Experience

The Journey to Freedom for Men (The Journey) is an invitation for men to grow into mature sons in relationship with God the Father and with one another — leading to transformation in individuals, families, and generations.

In a world where many men lack deep friendships and meaningful spiritual formation, The Journey creates space for honest conversation, shared experience, and personal renewal grounded in faith.

Through guided discussions, reflective exercises, and shared activities, men explore life's deepest questions: identity, purpose, truth, love, responsibility, and legacy.



Who Can Participate?

- Open to all men age 18 and older

- Join us for the introductory event and discover the Father's heart, deeper friendship, and a renewed purpose for your life

Identity. Many men unknowingly allow emotions, wounds, or past experiences to define who they are. The Journey helps men examine identity through a biblical lens. Participants explore:

- Personal identity and spiritual sonship
- Healing from shame and brokenness
- Emotional and relational health
- Authentic masculinity rooted in Christ

The Journey begins with a powerful shared experience: viewing *The Heart of Man*, a cinematic retelling of the Prodigal Son revealing God's compassionate pursuit of His sons.

Brotherhood. Men often stand shoulder-to-shoulder in activities but rarely walk heart-to-heart in friendship. The Journey combines:

- Outdoor fellowship
- Small-group dialogue
- Guided introspective exercises
- Confidential and supportive discussions

While some conversations may feel challenging, they open the door to genuine connection, accountability, and lasting brotherhood.

Legacy. As providers and leaders, men are called to steward resources wisely and prepare future generations. The Journey offers practical guidance through:

- Thinking Money: A Look at Our Best and Worst Financial Decisions
- Faith, Finances, and Your Future — investing principles from biblical and secular perspectives
- Put Your House in Order — estate planning and legacy preservation

Participants may continue learning through an optional Financial Intelligence Group for ongoing discussion and growth.
