### **Week 1: September 10-17**

#### **2 Peter 3:18 (NIV) - (IGNITE Theme Verse)**

*But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To him be the glory both now and forever. Amen.*

### **Week 2: September 17-24**

#### **Psalms 119:9-11 (Psalm 119 Club Verse)**

*How can a young man keep his way pure? By guarding it according to your word. With my whole heart I seek you; let me not wander from your commandments! I have stored up your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you.*

### **Week 3: September 24-October 1**

#### **Psalms 8:1**

*O LORD, our Lord, how majestic is your name in all the earth! You have set your glory above the heavens.*

### **Week 4: October 1-8**

#### **Philippians 4:8 (NIV)**

### **Week 5: October 8-15**

#### **Psalms 23:1-3**

*The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake.*

### **Week 6: October 15-22**

#### **Psalms 23:4-6**

*Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the LORD forever.*

**Week 8: October 29-November 5**

**Proverbs 3:5-6 (NIV)**

*Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight*

**Week 9: November 5-12**

**1 John 5:3-5**

*For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments. And his commandments are not burdensome. For everyone who has been born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world – our faith.*

**Week 10: November 12-19**

**Psalms 116:1-2**

*I love the LORD, because he has heard my voice and my pleas for mercy. Because he inclined his ear to me, therefore I will call on him as long as I live*

**Week 11 (Thanksgiving Break): November 19-December 3**

**Psalms 106:1**

*Praise the LORD! Oh give thanks to the LORD, for he is good, for his steadfast love endures forever!*

**Week 12: December 3-10**

**Psalms 100:1-2**

*Make a joyful noise to the LORD, all the earth! Serve the LORD with gladness! Come into his presence with singing!*

**Week 13: December 10-17**

**Isaiah 9:6**

*For to us a child is born, to us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder, and his name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace*

**Week 14 (Christmas Break): December 17-January 14**

**Luke 2:8-11 (NIV)**

*And there were shepherds living out in the fields nearby, keeping watch over their flocks at night. An angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were terrified. But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid, I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people. Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord*

**Week 15: January 14-21**

**James 1:2-5**

*Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds, for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness. And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing. If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask God who gives generously to all without reproach, and it will be given him.*

**Week 16: January 21-28**

**Philippians 2:3-4 (NIV)**

*Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others*

**Week 17: January 28-February 4**

**Philippians 4:6-7 (NIV)**

*Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.*

**Week 18: February 4-11**

**James 1:22 (NIV)**

*Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says.*

**Week 19: February 11-18**

**Psalms 139:14**

*I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works; my soul knows it very well.*

**Week 20: February 18-25**

**John 10:14-15**

*I am the good shepherd. I know my own and my own know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father; and I lay down my life for the sheep.*

**Week 21: February 25-March 4**

**Romans 1:16**

*For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek.*

**Week 22: March 4-11**

**Philippians 2:9-11 (NIV)**

*Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth.*

**Week 23: March 11-18**

**Matthew 28:19 (NIV)**

*Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,*

**Week 24: March 18-25**

**Romans 5:8**

*but God shows his love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.*

**Week 25 (Easter Break): March 25-April 15**

**1 Corinthians 15:55-58 (NIV)**

*"Where, O death, is your victory? Where, O death, is your sting?" The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters, stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain.*

**Week 26: April 15-April 22**

**John 3:36**

*Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him*

**Week 27: April 22-April 29**

**John 14:1-2**

*Let not your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in me. In my Father's house are many rooms. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you?*

**Week 28: April 29-May 6**

**Jude 24-25**

*Now to him who is able to keep you from stumbling and to present you blameless before the presence of his glory with great joy, to the only God, our Savior, through Jesus Christ our Lord, be glory, majesty, dominion, and authority, before all time and now and forever. Amen.*
