SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

After last week's interaction with the rich young man, Jesus gives a parable concerning reward in the kingdom. He presents a story that is meant to prompt a reaction as he speaks of a master that approaches work and reward in an unorthodox manner. What we are taught is that our Lord approaches things differently than we would and that the economy of the kingdom is not the same as that of the world.

Discussion Questions

- 1. Review: What did last week's passage (19:16-30) teach us concerning the risk and reward in following Christ?
- 2. In the immediate context, who is Jesus speaking this parable to? How does this parable connect with last week's passage on the rich young man?
- 3. If you put yourself in the position of the laborers who had worked all day, would you feel the same way as them about getting equal payment as those who came late? Why?
- 4. What does this parable teach us about the nature of the kingdom and of the master?
- 5. In what ways do you sometimes begrudge the Lord's generosity (20:15)? How does this parable serve as a warning to us?
- 6. How does this parable shape the way that we make Christ known to others? Why is this such good news to the world around us?
