SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

In chapter 32 of Genesis we find Jacob back in the land of promise. Jacob isn't quite settled because of one major, outstanding issue; he is going to have to face his brother whose birthright and blessing he stole. Though the fear that Jacob feels is crippling, it leads him to a unique encounter with God that defines him from that point forward.

Discussion Questions

- 1. Review: In what ways have we seen God's faithfulness in his promise to Jacob up to this point of the story?
- 2. Chapter 32 opens up with Jacob fearing his upcoming meeting with Esau. What practical steps does he take in his anticipation of it (32:3-8; 13-21)? Is he justified in taking these steps?
- 3. Read Jacob's prayer in 32:9-12. What does this prayer tell us about the state of Jacob's heart?
- 4. What is the significance of God wrestling with Jacob before his meeting with Esau? Why does God engage him in this way?
- 5. Why does God change Jacob's name to Israel? How does this relate to the situation that Jacob is about to face with his brother?
- 6. How does this story point to what Christ has done for us? How should this encourage us in the fears we face?
