SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

As we focus this week on a passage that has been an integral part of our VBS this year, we see one of the most familiar verses in the Bible. In spite of its familiarity, let's look again at it together and see what the Holy Spirit may use regarding this "I Am" statement of Jesus to help us grow in our love and worship of him this week.

Discussion Questions

- 1. What does Peter say in classic Peter fashion as Jesus meets with his disciples for this last meal?
- 2. What hard truth does Jesus bring to bear on Peter's claim of self-sacrifice and heroism?
- 3. What element of knowledge does Jesus assume about the disciples in John 14:4?
- 4. How would you describe the place you most want to be? How do various worldly things distract you from desiring the ultimate home, the ultimate finish line?
- 5. What portion of John 14:6 may be counterintuitive as we consider the words Jesus chose to use when speaking of himself and his relationship to salvation?
- 6. What is a challenge we face from the world when declaring this unilateral, decisive declaration from Jesus? Who in your life struggles to accept this claim of sole method of salvation and how can you pray for them in the weeks ahead?

A huge heartfelt **THANK YOU** to all of you who made our 2025 VBS "Route 14:6" a success. Grace Church, you really came together *To Make Christ Known*, whether it was through giving of your time in volunteering, decorating, or helping with other preparations' giving of your resources through helping us fulfill our donation wishlists and suitcase requests; or giving of your "trash" through collecting milk jug lids and TP rolls.

Not only did you give generously but you also invited passionately. We loved seeing and meeting so many new faces that came through our doors for this gospel-saturated week. From sports teams to neighbors to extended family members and more - you did a great job inviting kids from all over our community to hear about who Jesus is!

VBS in numbers:

- Over 200 kids came through our doors this week to hear about who Jesus is.
- Over 120 of those kids were not from Grace.
- Of that **120**, over **50** listed no church home.
- A team of **144** volunteers poured out 20 hours of energy over 5 mornings.
- 1200 water balloons were used.
- 1552 M&Ms were eaten.
- **1296** pieces of bubble gum were chewed.
- 210 skeins of embroidery floss were used.
- 200 toilet paper rolls and over 1000 milk jug lids were used.

Most importantly we learned that:

- Jesus is the Great I AM who we were designed to worship.
- Jesus is the Resurrection and the Life who makes us spiritually alive.
- Jesus is the Light of the World who gives us hope and guides us through a dark and sinful world.
- Jesus is the Way, the Truth, and the Life the only way we can be truly saved from sin and its consequences.
- Jesus is the Vine whom we must cling to daily.
- Jesus is the Good Shepherd whom the faithful can trust even in the most challenging and confusing circumstances.
- Our home is the City of Eternal Joy where we will spend forever celebrating the greatness and worth of God.
- Please continue to pray for all who came through our doors this past week. May the seeds that were planted through this week take strong root and produce fruit 30, 60, and 100 fold. To God be the Glory!
