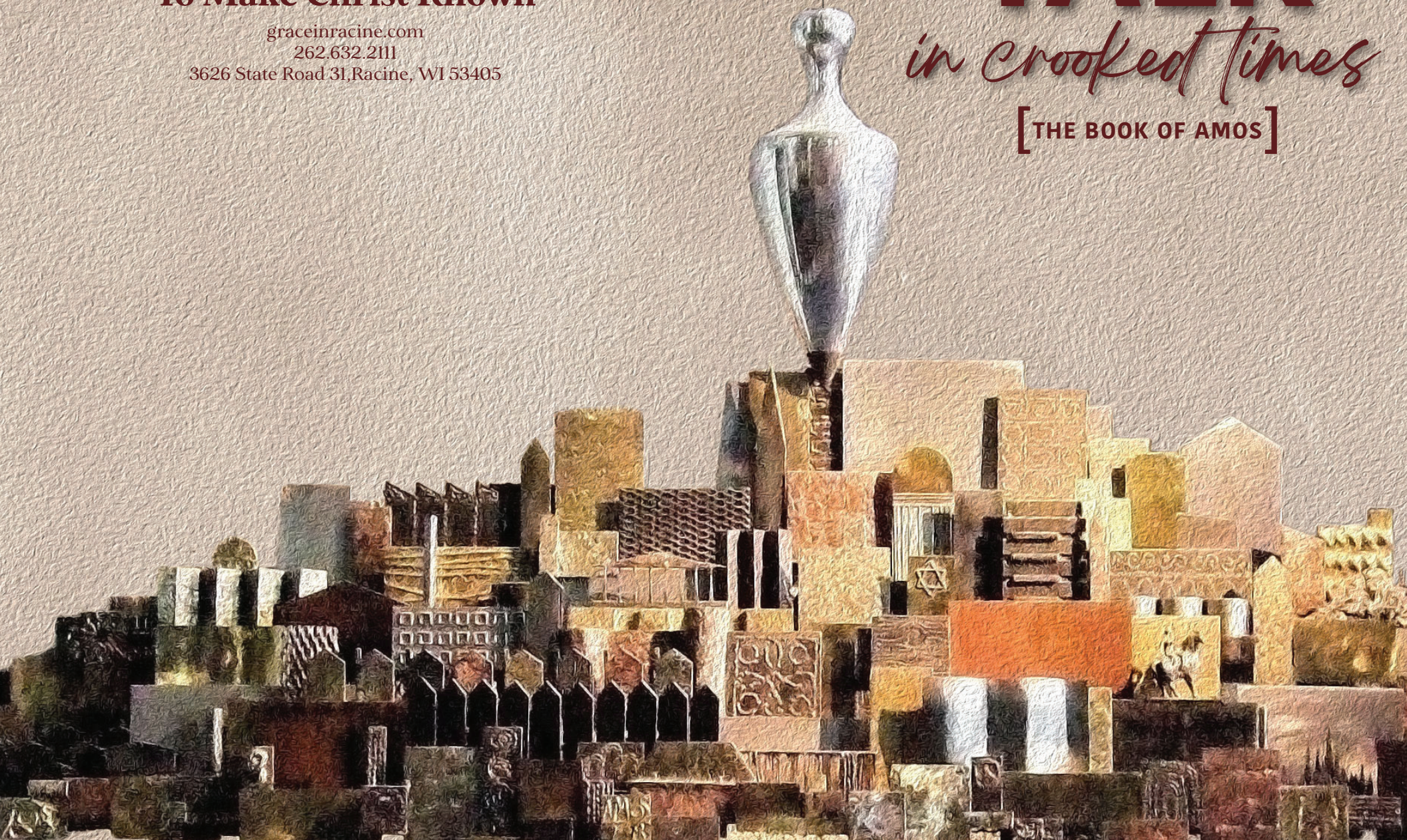

SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for after the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

This week, we conclude our study in the book of Amos. Although the book has consistently exposed Israel's sin and warned of God's coming judgment, it concludes with a message of hope. The Lord promises the future restoration that awaits those who remain faithful to Him.

Discussion Questions

1. Review: What has the Lord taught you from the book of Amos? In what ways have you been challenged over the last three months?
2. In verse 9:11, the Lord speaks about raising up the *"booth of David."* What does this mean and how is it in line with the promises that the Lord has made with his people before this (see 2 Samuel 7:12-13)?
3. What else is God promising to his people in 9:11-13? How do we see it fulfilled in the New Testament (read Acts 15:12-17)?
4. What is God saying about the level of abundance his people will experience when he restores all things (9:13)? What does it mean when he talks about the plowman overtaking the reaper and the treader of grapes overtaking the one who sows the seed?
5. What is the final promise that God makes in 9:15? In light of everything else in the book of Amos, what makes this promise so encouraging?
6. How is a book like Amos helpful in showing non-believers what God is like? How could it be used to share the good news of Jesus Christ?
