## SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

After the disciples come down from the Mount of Transfiguration, they are met with a father whose son is in desperate need of healing. They come to find out that they are unable to help the man, much to the dismay of Jesus. This opens up an opportunity for the Lord to teach them about the nature of faith and what it means to walk by it.

**Discussion Questions** 

- 1. Review: In regards to last week's sermon (17:1-13), whose voice tends to be the loudest in your life? In what situations do you struggle to listen to Jesus?
- 2. Why couldn't the disciples cast out the demon from the boy? Why was Jesus so seemingly harsh in his response to the disciples in verse 17?
- 3. Is Jesus contradicting himself by chastising them for their little faith while also calling them to faith even as small as a grain of mustard seed? What's the difference?
- 4. Given the events of 17:13-20, why were the disciples distressed when Jesus talked about his death and resurrection again in verses 22-23?
- 5. What does it look like for us to work unto the Lord in faith? Is he expecting us to miraculously move mountains?
- 6. How might a passage like this speak to someone who is exploring the gospel?
