SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

In this saga of Jacob's life, we come to the moment where he arrives at his journey's intended destination in the east. While it may seem that all is going as planned, Jacob is met with significant unintended troubles. Genesis 29 lays out events that are crucial in Jacob's formation as a man of God.

Discussion Questions

- 1. Review: What is the significance of Jacob's dream in 28:10-17 and how does it play out in the stories of the Bible going forward?
- 2. Jacob travels east and ends up in Haran. Where else have we seen Haran in Genesis and why is this an important detail considering the purpose in Jacob's journey?
- 3. Why was Jacob so quick to act when he saw Rachel in 29:10? What was he looking to accomplish?
- 4. How is Jacob's time with Laban in 29:21-30 almost a direct reflection of earlier events in Jacob's life; specifically from chapter 27? What makes these troubles with Laban so formative in Jacob's life?
- 5. God is not mentioned at all in this passage. So how is he at work in all of this?
- 6. How would you be able to share Christ from a story like this? What questions might a non-believer ask if they were to focus in on this passage?
