# **SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

After a wonderful Holy Week, we return back to our series in the gospel of Matthew where we are immediately met with another confrontation between Jesus and the religious leaders. They, again, demand a sign from the Lord and Jesus refuses to acquiesce. Jesus uses this as an opportunity to warn his disciples and show them that his ministry goes far deeper than meeting physical needs.

#### **Discussion Questions**

- 1. Miscommunications are common. Can you think of a time when you took someone literally when they were being figurative or looking to make a larger point? When reading or studying the Bible, why is the literary or historical context so important? What are some examples of passages or verses where we can misinterpret if we are overly literal?
- 2. Our current Sermon Series is all about the King and His People. From the last few chapters of Matthew, what are some things that have surprised you about Jesus and the people he gathers?
- 3. When the Pharisees and Sadducees test Jesus by asking him for a sign he tells them that no sign will be given except the sign of Jonah (Matthew 16:4). In a previous interaction (Matthew 12:38-42) Jesus connects to the sign of Jonah by saying "so will the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth." How is Jesus' death and resurrection similar to Jonah's being swallowed by a fish and how is it different? Why does it say that the people of Nineveh will rise up in judgement at this generation?
- 4. How is the resurrection of Jesus Christ "a greater" if not the greatest sign of who Jesus is? Have you ever considered the historical evidence for the resurrection of Jesus Christ? If so, what evidence do you find most compelling? One argument skeptics make is that the resurrection of Jesus is merely symbolic. Read 1 Corinthians 15:3-9. How might this passage help validate the authenticity of the resurrection?
- 5. Jesus refers to the disciples as "you of little faith" (Matthew 16:8), because they are preoccupied with their need for bread. What situations or physical needs tend to make your faith feel little? How can focusing on the greater sign of the resurrection help to increase your faith?
