## **SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

In this portion of Genesis, the focus is on Jacob's two wives, Leah and Rachel. It is another story of questionable decisions on the part of God's people, and we get to view how God is working through them. This "baby boom" serves as another example of the Lord's certainty to keep his promises through his providential work.

#### **Discussion Questions**

- 1. Review: In last week's passage, we were given an example of deception in Laban's dealings with Jacob. How was God at work in all of it?
- 2. At the end of Genesis 29, the Lord opens Leah's womb and she conceives four children. What does Leah's choice of names for her sons say about her?
- 3. When Rachel sees that she is not bearing children she offers her husband her servant to serve as a surrogate. In what way is this a repeat of earlier stories from Genesis? What does it tell us about Rachel?
- 4. In 30:14-18 there was a dispute over mandrakes. What are mandrakes and what was culturally significant about them? Why is this such a big deal to Leah and Rachel? How does this show where their hearts and belief in God's promises really are?
- 5. How does this story fit into the big picture of God's work throughout the Bible? In the big picture of the Bible, what is this passage really about and how was it meant to serve as an encouragement to the original audience that were on the cusp of taking the promised land?
- 6. How might God's work in this passage give us confidence in going out to share the gospel with others? How does it give us hope?
