SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for after the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

In the text this week, we look at some of the most famous miracles of our Lord. These miracles are familiar to many of us who have walked with Jesus for some time, their familiarity sometimes causes us to overlook what they are saying about the Lord and what it means for how we serve him.

Discussion Questions

- 1. Review: What do the two stories from last week teach us about the human response to God's messengers? How do we sometimes fall into the same error as the people of Jesus' hometown and Herod?
- 2. The passage begins with the feeding of the 5,000. Given the nature of this miracle and Israel's history of their wandering in the wilderness, what does this tell us about who Jesus is? Why does Matthew make a point to include the detail that there was so much left over?
- 3. What was Jesus demonstrating about himself by his walking on water? Why is it easy for us to often relate to Peter in this story?
- 4. When Jesus goes to Gennesaret and heals, people were asking just to touch the fringe of his garment. Why? What does this teach us about the nature of faith in Christ?
- 5. How do these stories form our understanding of who Jesus is? How do we sometimes view him as less than he really is?
- 6. Do you ever avoid talking about his miracles when sharing Christ with others? Why might that be tempting for us to do?
