SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for after the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

Advent is a season for us to reflect upon the profound miracle that God would become fully man in order to save us. But it is not something that is to be merely appreciated from afar. The incarnation of the living Lord is meant to be embraced in such a way that we are changed in meaningful and magnificent ways.

Discussion Questions

- 1. What has Advent meant to you over the years? What does it mean to you now?
- Read 1 Timothy 3:16. Why does Paul call this confession the mystery of godliness?
- 3. In verse 15, Paul refers to the church as a pillar and buttress of the truth. What does this mean and how does it guide us as we seek to be faithful as a local church?
- 4. Why must we be a people of the truth before everything else? Do you agree with this sentiment?
- 5. How does upholding the truth affect the way we behave in the household of God? What does it mean for the way we interact with one another?
- 6. How can we utilize the season and message of Advent to help others who are exploring the faith?
