SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

We have reached a crucial part of the Gospel of Matthew where Peter confesses Jesus as the Christ, and the Lord is overjoyed with it. Jesus' identity is not only made plain, but we also gain a greater understanding of what life as his followers actually entails.

Discussion Questions

- 1. Review: Thinking back on last week's sermon on Matthew 16:1-12, in what ways are we prone to test Jesus? How are we sometimes like the Sadducees and Pharisees?
- 2. In looking at verses 13-20, what is so significant about Peter's confession of Jesus as the Christ? What does Jesus mean when he tells him that "*on this rock*" he will build his church?
- 3. What does it mean and how should we respond to the fact that the gates of hell (Hades) shall not prevail against his church?
- 4. Why did Peter respond with rebuke toward Jesus in verses 21-23? What ideas about the Kingdom did Peter have in mind?
- 5. How does the message about the suffering of his followers in verses 24-28 actually serve as an encouragement to us? Is Jesus teaching that salvation comes through our works in verse 27? If not, what is he saying?
- 6. How do we include the reality of suffering when we talk to others about Christ? Why is it important that we don't leave that part out?
