# **SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

This week we took a look at the topic of assurance of salvation. Whether we can be sure that we are truly saved is a question that almost all believers struggle with from time to time, but it is not a question that lacks an answer.

#### **Discussion Questions**

- 1. Review: We just spent the last few months walking through another series in our journey through Matthew. What have you learned about the nature and magnitude of Jesus' authority?
- 2. Have you ever struggled with being assured of your own salvation? Why is this such a common struggle amongst believers in Christ?
- 3. Read 1 John 5:11-13. What is this passage teaching and how does it serve to bring comfort to those who are working through this issue for themselves?
- What is false assurance of salvation? What makes it so dangerous?
- Why is a person's relationship to the local church so important in regards to this issue? What part does the local church play for someone who is struggling with this?
- 6. How do unbelievers struggle with this question? How does a message like this bring hope to those who are exploring the gospel for themselves?

#### Globally: The INN (International Neighborhood Network)

The INN's vision is to connect with Muslim and Arabic-speaking communities from places in the world with limited or no gospel presence. As The INN plants local churches in the US, a natural outreach of these churches is to reach INN workers' and new believers' homelands.

Funds will be used for two conferences in Egypt to train and encourage Egyptian Pastors and adult leaders.

# Locally: Grace Local Partner HALO (The Homeless Assistance Leadership Organization)

HALO offers each person an opportunity to begin their journey from dependency toward self-sufficiency. Homelessness is a very real issue for Racine County. Racine continues to have the highest unemployment rate and second highest child homelessness rate among Wisconsin cities. Last year, HALO served 700 individuals including 138 children, 58% under the age of six. One of the most important ways we can help individuals is by providing shelter, food, hygiene items and case management. Your financial gifts enable us to continue to assist the individuals at HALO.
