SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

Genesis 35 marks the end of the story of Jacob and brings our summer series to a close. In this last chapter Jacob moves further into the promised land with his family while experiencing some tragedy along the way. Though the saga of Jacob ends here, the story of the promise carries on well beyond him.

Discussion Questions

- 1. Review: How does accepting the fact that "while proper justice is right, it's often unsatisfying," shape the way we move through life as Christians?
- 2. What are some examples from this week's passage that show us the transformation that has taken place in Jacob?
- 3. Read the promise God made to Jacob in 28:13-15 and then in this week's chapter (35:10-12). What are some of the differences in what God tells him between these two events? Looking forward, how do these promises eventually get fulfilled?
- 4. Verse 22 presents a situation that seemingly comes out of nowhere in the overall story. Why is it significant enough for the author to mention it; especially regarding the future of the promise (see Genesis 49:3-4)?
- 5. Is this a satisfying or unsatisfying way for the story of Jacob to end?
- 6. What has this series on the life of Jacob taught you about God and the gospel? How might it shape the way you do gospel ministry with others?
