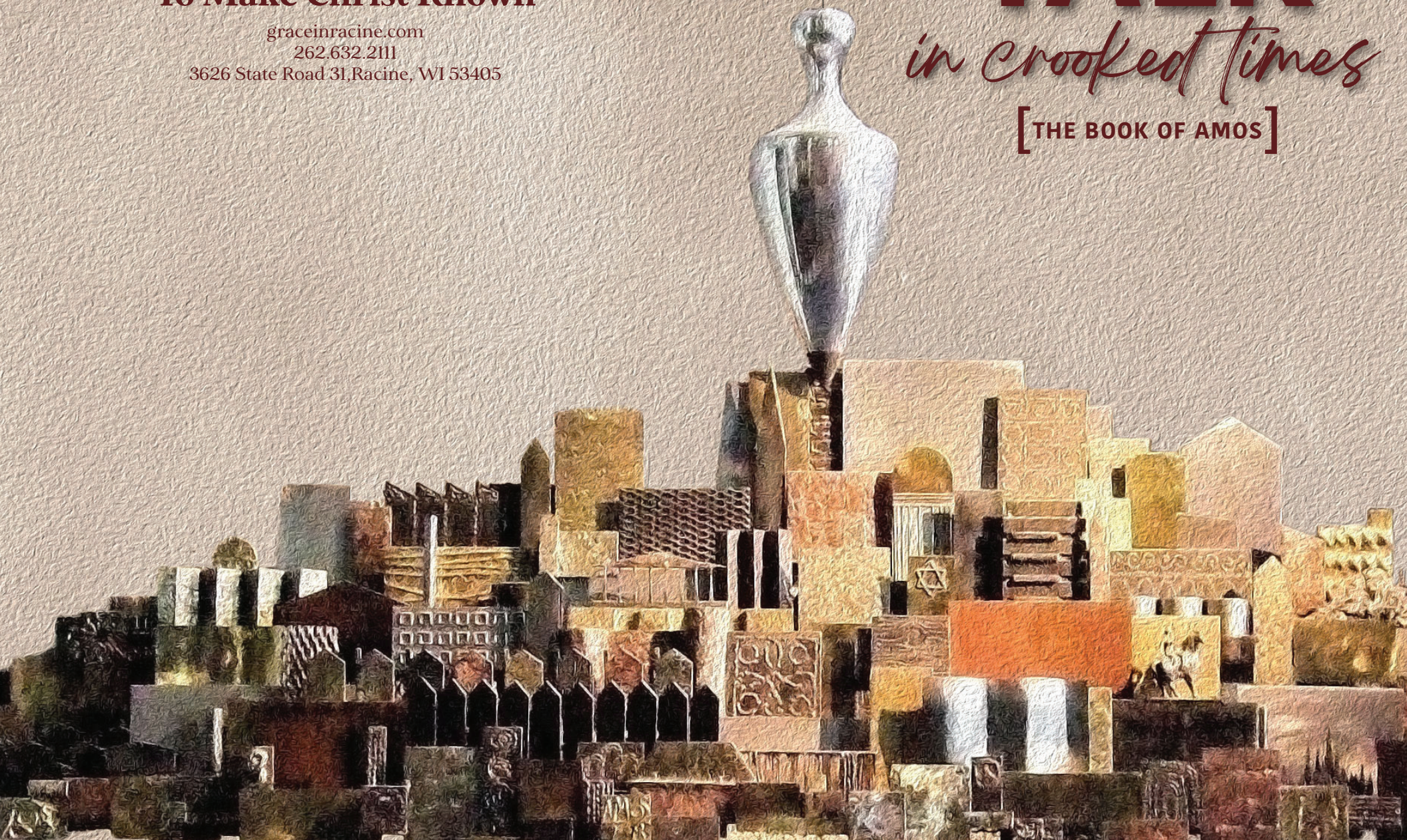

SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for after the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

As we continue through the book of Amos, God further exposes Israel's sin and their determination to persist in disobedience. Yet, God's plans will always prevail. In 8:4-14, we see a people who insist on ignoring the word of the Lord, as well as the overwhelming magnitude of the judgment that awaits them.

Discussion Questions

1. Review: What was God saying about Israel through the visions of the plumbline and the basket of summer fruit?
2. What is the chief concern of the people of Israel as demonstrated in 8:4-6? How does it affect the way they treat each other?
3. What does God promise about the nature of their judgment in 8:7-10? What is God saying about the extent of their punishment by using the imagery of the Nile River and the sun going down in the middle of the day?
4. Back in 7:1-3, God relents from his given vision of causing a famine in Israel but then promises a famine in 8:11-12. What kind of famine are they going to experience? How is the promised famine to come a fitting judgment for Israel?
5. What will happen to the northern kingdom of Israel according to 8:13-14? Does this mean there was no hope for the original audience of this message?
6. How do we see Christ in a passage like this? How might we use verses like 8:9-10 to explain to a non-believer the nature of Jesus' willing sacrifice for his people?
