SERMON REVIEW DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

These questions are for *after* the sermon and can be used for Life Group discussion, one-to-one discipleship, or personal reflection and application.

In the latter half of Matthew 19, we come across the familiar story of the rich young man who asks Jesus what he needs to do to get eternal life. It's a unique interaction in the Gospel because it's one of the few places where someone approaches Jesus in full sincerity and yet walks away in sorrow. This is a story that cuts right to the heart of what it really looks like to follow Christ and one that often brings conviction when we dig into it.

Discussion Questions

- 1. Review: What did last week's passage (19:1-15) have to say about the nature of Jesus' authority and what it looks like to truly follow him?
- 2. When Jesus initially responds to the rich young man and points out that "*There is only one who is good*" in verse 17; what is the point he is making?
- 3. When Jesus commands the rich young man to sell everything and follow him, why couldn't he do it and why did it cause him sorrow? How might we identify with the rich young man when we consider what we must give up to follow Jesus faithfully?
- 4. Why were the disciples astonished (vs. 25) when they heard what Jesus had to say about how difficult it is for a rich person to enter the kingdom of heaven? Why was this teaching so counter-cultural?
- 5. Is Jesus telling all of us to neglect our families and responsibilities in order to properly follow him? How should we understand what verse 29 means for us?
- 6. How often do you include the cost of following Christ alongside the reward when sharing the gospel with others? Why is it so important to not neglect either?
