Association of Related Churches (ARC)

- As an ARC church, we seek to continue our long-time commitment to ARC and its mission. ARC has helped plant over 1,100 churches since its inception.

Project Cost: \$296,000

Amount Funded: \$167,405.96

Amount Needed: \$128,594.04
