
DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

TABERNACLE PRAYER FRAMEWORK

God provides a pattern of prayer that forms our hearts as we enter His presence.



Exodus 33:11 NLT

Inside the Tent of Meeting, the Lord would speak to Moses <u>face to face, as one speaks</u> to a friend.

- 1. Brazen altar = I focus on the cross
- 2. Lavar = I offer every part of my life to God
- 3. The candlestick = I invite the work of the Holy Spirit in my life
- 4. **Table of showbread** = I feed on God's word and use it as a weapon against the enemy
- 5. Altar of incense = I worship His name
- 6. Ark of the covenant = I intercede for others
