

Stranger Things Revelation 10

📖 Acts 17:6b (ESV) "... "These men who have turned the world upside down have come here also,""

It's strange that [there's a pause between every 6th and 7th judgment.](#)

- The Interlude within the 7 **Seals**: Revelation 7.
- The Interlude within the 7 **Trumpets**: Revelation 10-11:14.
- The Interlude within the 7 **Bowls**: Revelation 16:13-16.

It's strange when [two options are equally feasible.](#)

📖 Revelation 10:1a (NIV84) "Then I saw another mighty angel coming down from heaven."

1. Some believe that the mighty angel is **Jesus**.

📖 Revelation 10:1b-3 "He was robed in a cloud, with a rainbow above his head; his face was like the sun, and his legs were like fiery pillars. ² He was holding a little scroll, which lay open in his hand. He planted his right foot on the sea and his left foot on the land, ³ and he gave a loud shout like the roar of a lion. When he shouted, the voices of the seven thunders spoke."

2. Others believe the mighty angel is **an archangel**.

📖 Revelation 10:1a (NIV84) "Then I saw **ANOTHER** mighty angel coming down from heaven."

📖 Revelation 10:5-7 (NIV84) "Then the angel I had seen standing on the sea and on the land raised his right hand to heaven. ⁶ And he swore by Him who lives for ever and ever, who created the heavens and all that is in them, the earth and all that is in it, and the sea and all that is in it..."

📖 John 1:1-3 (NIV84) "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ² He was with God in the beginning. ³ Through Him all things were made; without Him nothing was made that has been made."

📖 Revelation 10:6b-7 (NIV84) "... "There will be no more delay! ⁷ But in the days when the seventh angel is about to sound his trumpet, the mystery of God will be accomplished, just as He announced to His servants the prophets."

📖 Revelation 10:4 (NIV84) "And when the seven thunders spoke, I was about to write; but I heard a voice from heaven say, "Seal up what the seven thunders have said and do not write it down."

📖 Genesis 26:34-35 (NIV84) "When Esau was forty years old, he married Judith daughter of Beeri the Hittite, and also Basemath daughter of Elon the Hittite. ³⁵ They were a source of grief to Isaac and Rebekah."

📖 2 Corinthians 12:3-4 (NIV84) "...I know that this man—whether in the body or apart from the body I do not know, but God knows— ⁴ was caught up to paradise. He heard inexpressible things, things that man is not permitted to tell."

📖 Proverbs 11:13 (NIV84) "A gossip betrays a confidence, but a trustworthy man keeps a secret."

📖 Proverbs 26:20 (NIV84) "Without wood a fire goes out; without gossip a quarrel dies down."

📖 James 1:26 (NIV84) "If anyone considers himself religious and yet does not keep a tight rein on his tongue, he deceives himself and his religion is worthless."

It's strange when [something sweet turns to something sour.](#)

📖 Revelation 10:8-11 (NIV84) "Then the voice that I had heard from heaven spoke to me once more: "Go, take the scroll that lies open in the hand of the angel who is standing on the sea and on the land." ⁹ So I went to the angel and asked him to give me the little scroll. He said to me, "Take it and eat it. It will turn your stomach sour, but in your mouth it will be as sweet as honey." ¹⁰ I took the little scroll from the angel's hand and ate it. It tasted as sweet as honey in my mouth, but when I had eaten it, my stomach turned sour. ¹¹ Then I was told, "You must prophesy again about many peoples, nations, languages and kings."

📖 Ezekiel 3:1-3, 10-11 (NLT) "The voice said to me, "Son of man, eat what I am giving you—eat this scroll! Then go and give its message to the people of Israel." ² So I opened my mouth, and He fed me the scroll. ³ "Fill your stomach with this," He said. And when I ate it, it tasted as sweet as honey in my mouth... ¹⁰ Then He added, "Son of man, let all my words sink deep into your own heart first. Listen to them carefully for yourself. ¹¹ THEN go to your people in exile and say to them, 'This is what the Sovereign Lord says!' Do this whether they listen to you or not."

📖 2 Corinthians 2:15-16a (NIV84) "For we are to God the aroma of Christ among those who are being saved and those who are perishing. ¹⁶ To the one we are the smell of death; to the other, the fragrance of life."
