Revelation 22:6-21

The Last **PROMISE** in the Bible.

📖 Revelation 22:6-7 (NIV84) “The angel said to me, ‘These words are trustworthy and true. ‘ “ The Lord, the God of the spirits of the prophets, sent His angel to show His servants the things that must soon take place.”

7 “Behold, I am coming soon! Blessed is he who keeps the words of the prophecy in this book.”

📖 1 Corinthians 15:51-52 (NIV84) “Listen, I tell you a mystery: We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed—⁵² in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed.”

📖 Luke 17:24 (NLT) “For as the lightning flashes and lights up the sky from one end to the other, so it will be on the day when the Son of Man comes.”

📖 2 Peter 3:9 (NIV84) “The Lord is not slow in keeping His promise, as some understand slowness. He is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.”

📖 Revelation 22:8-11 (NIV84) “I, John, am the one who heard and saw these things. And when I had heard and seen them, I fell down to worship at the feet of the angel who had been showing them to me.⁹ But he said to me, “Do not do it! I am a fellow servant with you and with your brothers the prophets and of all who keep the words of this book. Worship God!”¹⁰ Then he told me, “Do not seal up the words of the prophecy of this book, because the time is near.¹¹ Let him who does wrong continue to do wrong; let him who is vile continue to be vile; let him who does right continue to do right; and let him who is holy continue to be holy.”

The last **INVITATION** in the Bible.

📖 Revelation 22:12-17 (NIV84) “Behold, I am coming soon! My reward is with me, and I will give to everyone according to what he has done.¹³ I am the Alpha and the Omega, the First and the Last, the Beginning and the End.¹⁴ “Blessed are those who wash their robes, that they may have the right to the tree of life and may go through the gates into the city.¹⁵ Outside are the dogs, those who practice magic arts, the sexually immoral, the murderers, the idolaters and everyone who loves and practices falsehood.”

📖 Revelation 22:16-17 (NIBV84) “I, Jesus, have sent my angel to give you this testimony for the churches. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, and the bright Morning Star.”¹⁷ The Spirit and the bride say, “Come!” And let him who hears say, “Come!” Whoever is thirsty, let him come; and whoever wishes, let him take the free gift of the water of life.”

📖 John 4:14 (NIV84) “...whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give him will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life.”

The last **BREATH** in the Bible.

📖 Revelation 22:18-19 (NIV84) “I warn everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: If anyone adds anything to them, God will add to him the plagues described in this book.¹⁹ And if anyone takes words away from this book of prophecy, God will take away from him his share in the tree of life and in the holy city, which are described in this book.”

📖 2 Timothy 3:16a (NIV84) “All Scripture is God-breathed...”

📖 2 Peter 1:20-21 (NIV84) “Above all, you must understand that no prophecy of Scripture came about by the prophet’s own interpretation.²¹ For prophecy never had its origin in the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit.”

7 Reasons to Read the Bible:

1. The Bible provides **truth**. (John 8:32)
2. The Bible provides **encouragement**. (Romans 15:4)
3. The Bible provides **nourishment**. (Matthew 4:4)
4. The Bible provides **guidance**. (Psalm 119:105)
5. The Bible provides **strength**. (Psalm 119:11)
6. The Bible provides **protection**. (Proverbs 30:5)
7. The Bible provides **peace**. (Psalm 19:8)

The last **PRAYER** in the Bible.

📖 Revelation 22:20-21 (NIV84) “He who testifies to these things says, “Yes, I am coming soon.” Amen. Come, Lord Jesus.²¹ The grace of the Lord Jesus be with God’s people. Amen.”
