

## Thy Kingdom Come Revelation 11:15-19

📖 Matthew 6:9–13 (NIV84) “This, then, is how you should pray: “Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, <sup>10</sup> your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. <sup>11</sup> Give us today our daily bread. <sup>12</sup> Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. <sup>13</sup> And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.”

📖 Hebrews 11:1 (NIV84) “Now faith is being sure of what we hope for and certain of what we do not see.”

### The **KINGDOM** of God **ON EARTH**.

📖 Revelation 11:15 (NIV84) “The seventh angel sounded his trumpet, and there were loud voices in heaven, which said: “The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of His Christ, and He will reign for ever and ever.”

📖 Psalm 24:1 (NIV84) “The earth is the Lord’s, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it;”

#### Judgement Time Frames:

- The 7 **SEAL** judgments encompass **all seven years** of the Tribulation.
- The 7 **TRUMPET** judgments encompass **the last half** of the Tribulation.
- The 7 **BOWL** judgments encompass **the last few weeks/days** of the Tribulation.

### The **WORSHIP** of God **IN HEAVEN**.

📖 Revelation 11:16–17 (NIV84) “And the twenty-four elders, who were seated on their thrones before God, fell on their faces and worshiped God, <sup>17</sup> saying: “We give thanks to you, Lord God Almighty, the One who is and who was, because you have taken your great power and have begun to reign.”

📖 Revelation 4:4 (NIV84) “Surrounding the throne were twenty-four other thrones, and seated on them were twenty-four elders. They were dressed in white and had crowns of gold on their heads.”

📖 Luke 22:28–30 (NIV84) “You are those who have stood by me in my trials. <sup>29</sup> And I confer on you a kingdom, just as my Father conferred one on me, <sup>30</sup> so that you may eat and drink at my table in my kingdom and sit on thrones, judging the twelve tribes of Israel.”

### The **JUDGMENT** of God **ON ALL**.

📖 Revelation 11:18 (NIV84) “The nations were angry; and your wrath has come. The time has come for judging the dead, and for rewarding your servants the

prophets and your saints and those who reverence your name, both small and great— and for destroying those who destroy the earth.”

- God will **judge the dead**.
- God will **reward His servants**.
- God will **destroy the destroyers**.

📖 Matthew 25:31–46 (NIV84) “When the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the angels with Him, He will sit on His throne in heavenly glory. <sup>32</sup> All the nations will be gathered before Him, and He will separate the people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats. <sup>33</sup> He will put the sheep on His right and the goats on His left. <sup>34</sup> “Then the King will say to those on His right, ‘Come, you who are blessed by my Father; take your inheritance, the kingdom prepared for you since the creation of the world. <sup>35</sup> For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, <sup>36</sup> I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was sick and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me.’ <sup>37</sup> “Then the righteous will answer Him, ‘Lord, when did we see you hungry and feed you, or thirsty and give you something to drink? <sup>38</sup> When did we see you a stranger and invite you in, or needing clothes and clothe you? <sup>39</sup> When did we see you sick or in prison and go to visit you?’ <sup>40</sup> “The King will reply, ‘I tell you the truth, whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of mine, you did for me.’ <sup>41</sup> “Then He will say to those on His left, ‘Depart from me, you who are cursed, into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and His angels. <sup>42</sup> For I was hungry and you gave me nothing to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me nothing to drink, <sup>43</sup> I was a stranger and you did not invite me in, I needed clothes and you did not clothe me, I was sick and in prison and you did not look after me.’ <sup>44</sup> “They also will answer, ‘Lord, when did we see you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or needing clothes or sick or in prison, and did not help you?’ <sup>45</sup> “He will reply, ‘I tell you the truth, whatever you did not do for one of the least of these, you did not do for me.’ <sup>46</sup> “Then they will go away to eternal punishment, but the righteous to eternal life.”

### The **PRESENCE** of God **WITH US**.

📖 Revelation 11:19a (NIV84) “Then God’s temple in heaven was opened, and within His temple was seen the ark of His covenant...”

📖 Revelation 21:1–4 (NIV84) “Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and there was no longer any sea. <sup>2</sup> I saw the Holy City, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride beautifully dressed for her husband. <sup>3</sup> And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, “Now the dwelling of God is with men, and He will live with them. They will be His people, and God Himself will be with them and be their God. <sup>4</sup> He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away.”

 Revelation 11:19b (NIV84) “...And there came flashes of lightning, rumblings, peals of thunder, an earthquake and a great hailstorm.”
