Revelation 2:12–17 (NIV84) "To the angel of the church in Pergamum write: These are the words of Him who has the sharp, double-edged sword. <sup>13</sup> I know where you live—where Satan has his throne. Yet you remain true to my name. You did not renounce your faith in me, even in the days of Antipas, my faithful witness, who was put to death in your city—where Satan lives. <sup>14</sup> Nevertheless, I have a few things against you: You have people there who hold to the teaching of Balaam, who taught Balak to entice the Israelites to sin by eating food sacrificed to idols and by committing sexual immorality. <sup>15</sup> Likewise, you also have those who hold to the teaching of the Nicolaitans. <sup>16</sup> Repent therefore! Otherwise, I will soon come to you and will fight against them with the sword of my mouth. <sup>17</sup> He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who overcomes, I will give some of the hidden manna. I will also give him a white stone with a new name written on it, known only to him who receives it."

# The <u>incision</u> of Christ.

- Revelation 2:12 (NIV84) "To the angel of the church in Pergamum write: These are the words of Him who has the sharp, double-edged sword."
- Hebrews 4:12-13 (NIV) "For the word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart. <sup>13</sup> Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of Him to whom we must give account."

# The **insight** of Christ.

- Revelation 2:13a (NIV84) "I know where you live—where Satan has his throne. Yet you remain true to my name."
- Revelation 2:13b (NIV84) You did not renounce your faith in me, even in the days of Antipas, my faithful witness, who was put to death in your city—where Satan lives."

# The intolerance of Christ.

- Revelation 2:14–16 (NIV84) "Nevertheless, I have a few things against you: You have people there who hold to the teaching of Balaam, who taught Balak to entice the Israelites to sin by eating food sacrificed to idols and by committing sexual immorality. <sup>15</sup> Likewise you also have those who hold to the teaching of the Nicolaitans. <sup>16</sup> Repent therefore! Otherwise, I will soon come to you and will fight against them with the sword of my mouth."
  - 1. They tolerated people who held to the teaching of Balaam:
  - 2. They <u>tolerated</u> people who held to the teaching of <u>the Nicolaitans</u>.

#### The incentive of Christ.

Revelation 2:17 (NIV84) "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who overcomes, I will give some of the hidden manna. I will also give him a white stone with a new name written on it, known only to him who receives it."
