8. What does Jesus mean when He says, "I have overcome the world"? How does His victory over the world affect the believer's present struggles and future hope?
9. What practical steps help you keep Christ at the center of your life during busy or stressful seasons?
10. What does this passage reveal about the heart or character of Jesus?
