## 1. Observation

- What words or pictures stood out to you in this psalm?
- Is there a part that made you liked the most?
- Is there a part that was confusing?

## 2. Emotion

- How do you think the writer of this psalm was feeling?
- Does this Psalm sound more like a happy song, a sad song, or a prayer for help?
- How does this psalm make you feel?

## 3. God

- What does this Psalm tell us about what God is like?
- What does this Psalm tell us about what God does?

## 4. Connection

- What does this Psalm encourage us to do?
- How might this Psalm help us when we're scared / happy / thankful / upset?
- What's one thing we could thank God for today, like the psalmist does?

## 5. Response

- Is there a situation, or a person, we could pray for after reading this Psalm?
- What's one thing we can remember about God this week because of this Psalm?
