Length:

Hours:

Approximate hour allocation:

- 1-2 hrs- Weekly youth preparation.
- 1 hr- Weekly meeting rotating between ministry discernment, spiritual formation, and ministry skill set growth.
- 0-2 hrs- Other things that come up, administration, and connecting with students.

- Personality Assessments
