 - What does the parable of the talents teach us about God's expectations for our stewardship of His gifts?
- In what ways can we see faithfulness as a core characteristic of the relationship between God and His people?

- How can we cultivate faithfulness in our daily lives to reflect the character of Christ?
 - What does faithfulness look like when we're with family or friends?
