In this environment we are able to help your child develop in four key skill areas...

- Motor Skills
- Social Skills
- Intellectual Skills
- Spiritual Skills

MOTOR SKILLS

We focus on fine motor skills through puzzles, beading, painting, cutting, gluing and other activities.

We focus on gross motor skills through gym activities.



INTELLECTUAL SKILLS

Your child will be exposed to new ideas and experiences through a variety of activities and themes. The goal of this program is for your child to be exposed to (not necessarily master) concepts of colors, shapes, numbers, and letters.



SOCIAL SKILLS

Your child will learn to interact with peers in a group setting and take direction from adults other than their parents/caregivers. Your child will find school a good and fun place to be and will develop curiosity, cooperation and kindergarten readiness.



SPIRITUAL SKILLS

Through the programs offered at Forest Grove Preschool, your child will be exposed to some basic teachings of the Christian faith as laid out in the Bible.



DAILY SCHEDULE:

Although our schedule may change from day to day, your child will normally engage in: a welcome time and free play, circle time (including activities, stories, games, teaching and songs, all related to the monthly theme), craft time, playing in the gym, a snack, and a closing time.

Our goal is to provide a safe, fun and welcoming environment for your child to learn and grow.

ELIGIBILITY:

- To attend the 3 year old classes, children must be three years of age by September 1 of the start of the school year
- To attend the 4 year old class, children must be four years of age by December 31
- Children must be toilet trained

SESSIONS:

3/4 Year Old Split Class

- Monday and Wednesday mornings

4 Year Old Class

- Tuesday and Thursday mornings

All Classes:

- Classes are from 9:15am-11:15am
- Preschool term from September to May
- Christmas, Easter and statutory holidays are observed

FEES:

- \$50 non-refundable registration fee per child is required at registration
- \$110/month
