TITUS 2:7-8




God, give our kids a tenacity to go after Your will. Help them desire to spend time with You, both in prayer and in Your Word. When their friends are distracted by the world or caught up in time wastes, raise up our kids to be an example of devotion to You.

Give us the strength to lead our children in this area so they can lead others in turn. Help us

to set an example of time well-spent and lives well-lived.
















COLOSSIANS 3:2

² Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things. (NIV)

God, it is so easy to have "tunnel vision" on ourselves in this fast-moving world. We ask that our kids can be known for their generosity. Help them to hold tightly to You and not to things of the world. Give them a willingness to help others from the overflow of what You have given them.

In the areas where they are more selfish and resistant to share, help them to genuinely recognize how little they deserve any of it. Show them how poorly it reflects on You when we greedily claim things as our own instead of giving all ownership to You.

Help our children to understand the gift they've been given. Let them understand Your generosity to the point that they look at giving as an opportunity and not a heavy obligation.

Please give them the joy that comes with giving their lives away.







ROMANS 6:16

¹⁶Don't you know that when you offer yourselves to someone as obedient slaves, you are slaves of the one you obey - whether you are slaves to sin, which leads to death, or to obedience, which leads to righteousness? (NIV)

Lord, help our children to be obedient in everything. At the times they are tempted to disobey, remind them that there is a better way. There is Your way. And that leads to righteousness and purity.

In the midst of the disobedience of others, give our children the strength to stand firm. Give them courage to speak up and make right decisions.

Father, we know how easy it for us to let our thoughts turn from You. Give us reminders to set our hearts and minds on You instead of on our own sinful desires. Help us to realize the peace that comes with submission to Your will.

Help us to delight in Your Law and Your Will without wavering. Show us the benefits of obeying You so that we may lead our children in a way that models obedience.

⁶Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid or terrified because of them, for the Lord Your God goes with you; He will never leave you nor forsake you. (NIV)

Lord, in the times our children feel alone, help them to sense Your presence. Remind them that You are watching over them and that they can call out to You from any desert in which they are lost.

In the scary moments, speak courage and hope to them. When they feel that they have been forgotten, encourage them to walk in the light of Your promise that You have never left them or forsaken them.








Give our children a heart for Your Word

Lord, when life seems unfair to our children and they experience what they see as injustice, overwhelm them with the truth of Your love and help them to follow Your path of justice.


Instead of focusing on their perceived lack, let them find joy in the gain that is You. Help us to be a model to them of what Godly reliance looks like.

Father God, cultivate a heart of contentment in our children. Help them to trust in Your provision instead of struggling with doubt, envy, or fear.


You are able to provide for us. We need to trust in that. What You have already provided us with is more than enough.


Help our children to find freedom in contentment. In all situations, give us the strength to rely on You and not on the comforts or promises of the world.

Father, sometimes life can seem hopeless. Death and grief are real and can feel unsurmountable at times. In those moments, we pray that you bring the story of the resurrection of Jesus to our children's minds.


You breathed life into the grave and put a new beginning on an end. You have not given up on us. We hold tight to Your promises and are confident to put our trust in You in the midst of our storms.

PSALMS 145:18


¹⁸The Lord is near to all who call on Him, to all who call on Him in truth. (NIV)

We pray specifically that our children learn how You love us by the direct way we love on them. Through our prayers, may our children learn how to pray to You and grow in their individual relationship with You.




GALATIANS 1:10





Allow their friends to see Your Spirit moving in our children, giving our children the affirmation that can only come from You.

Let the joy that comes from pleasing You significantly outweigh the compliments of others. Let their love for You drive their actions and words so that it positively impacts all their relationships.

PROVERBS 12:18

¹⁸The words of the reckless pierce like swords, but the tongue of the wise brings healing. (NIV)

We lift our children up to You, God. We pray You continue to grow them into the Godly people You made them to be. Keep their hearts pure so they may show Your Love to anyone they encounter. Help them to focus on You, and let them know that all good things come from You.

We pray they will overflow with Your joy so much that they want to pass it on to anyone they meet. Strengthen their minds so that they have the capacity to understand You and speak only messages of love.

We pray our children use their voices to encourage and lift others up. May they be filled with Your wisdom and may Your Word be hidden in their hearts so deep that it will never leave them.



JOSHUA 1:7

⁷Be strong and very courageous. Be careful to obey all the law my servant Moses gave you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, that you may be successful wherever you go. (NIV)

Father God, help our kids be filled with courage and always rely on Your strength instead of their own. When they encounter a situation that terrifies them, remind them that it doesn't terrify You.

You work in those moments. You never leave us during those moments.

We don't need to let our lives be controlled by fear because of Your strength and overwhelming love for us.

We pray that, as parents, our constant goal is to show our children what it looks like to be brave and to trust in You. In turn, may our children be quick to call on You when they are scared or in times of doubt.

MICAH 6:8


⁸He has shown you, O mortal, what is good. And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God. (NIV)


God, please give our children tender hearts. Help us teach them to forgive and appreciate grace.

When they are tempted to withhold forgiveness, remind them that You didn't and that any mercy they show is a reflection of Your love.

Teach us to rely on Your faithfulness and understanding of justice more than our own.

As parents, put us in situations where we need to model forgiveness for our kids, setting the example for them.





ROMANS 12:1


¹Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God - this is your true and proper worship. (NIV)

Lord, today we pray for discernment for our kids. As they grow in Your Word and get to know You more, we ask that sin becomes so distasteful to them that they rebuke it, run from it, or refuse to participate in it.

Surround them with people of this same mindset. Let them find friends who encourage and help each other in striving to meet Your standards. Protect them from evil influences.

When our kids fail or give in to sin, we ask that You quickly remind them of Your grace so that they don't lose hope or heart over past failings.

Thank You, Father God, for Your gift of grace.



DEUTERONOMY 1:30

³⁰The Lord your God, who is going before you, will fight for you, as he did for you in Egypt, before your very eyes... (NIV)

Father, we humbly ask that You give our children an unwavering faith that You are eager and able to fight on their behalf.

In the midst of storms, remind them that You are their Great Defender. You step in and fight for us. If they are currently in a storm, please step in and fight for them now. If the storm is yet to come, give them the faith to rely on You when it arrives.

When our kids feel cornered, stuck, or weak, we ask that You calm their fears and replace their weakness with Your strength.

ROMANS 8:28

²⁸And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose. (NIV)

Father God, please give our children the gift of Your compassion. Help them be aware of those who don't know You, and give them the tools to address the sadness and desperation of those they may encounter.

Help our children see with Your eyes and that they view the poor, not as inferior, but as brothers and sisters who need help, resources, and prayer. We ask that You bind the world from giving our children a distorted view of Your heart for us.


In all things You are working for the good of those who love You. We claim that promise. Help us to speak and act in love for You so that our children have a Godly example to follow.

God, remind us to be diligent in our pursuit of You. We need to be thorough in our relationship with You so that our children see examples of diligent devotion.





Thank You for being a loving Father to us.


Remind us to be diligent in our pursuit of You

Father, help our kids have a desire and a willingness to be hospitable. Help them to remember that You have instructed us to be good stewards of our blessings.


Help us make our home into a place where people who don't know You are able to sense You. May our home be a place where those who do know You are able to rest and be in Your presence.

Give them an urge to seek and listen to Your voice. Help them to be dependable servants of all You have given them.

When the world wants to remind them of their failures, remind our kids that You love to use the weak to show Your strength. Teach them the value of making the right choice, no matter how hard.

As parents, let us be people that demonstrate courage and faithfulness in the battles we fight. Let us set an example of faith for our children. You are mighty to save.





JAMES 5:16

¹⁶Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective. (NIV)

God, create a disciplined prayer life in our children. Direct their thoughts, conversations, and requests. In their prayer time, reveal Your promises and love for them.

Remind our kids that prayer is not the "last resort." Give them an urgency to come to You first; in praise, in frustration, in fear, and in need.

When they feel like they aren't seeing an answer from You, let them not grow weary in prayer. Give them patience and tell them that You will see them through to the last detail. Help them remember that nothing has been left to chance.
