BEFORE/AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM (EXPLORERS CLUB)

Explorers Club is a program at Bell Shoals designed to help parents of who need care for their children on a regular basis beyond the hours of the school day. Explorers Club offers supervision and a variety of enrichment activities for children from our ELC through 8th grade. Families may choose part time care (1 to 3 days per week) or full time care (4 to 5 days per week). Daily activities include homework time, snack time, supervised free play, crafts and organized games. For safety and staffing requirements all enrollment intentions must be prescheduled. Morning care begins at 6:30 AM. After care ends at 6:00 PM. Fees are published on our website.

THE FINE PRINT

The application and enrollment fees are required to be paid regardless of intent to use a state sponsored scholarship and are non-refundable. The balance of tuition is paid monthly via automatic debits through FACTS. You may choose to have the payments debited on the 5th or the 20th of each month. FACTS charges an annual fee for this service of \$55 per family. Tuition can be paid in 9 installments with the first payment being in August and the final payment in April. Tuition includes safety and tech fees, books, insurance, some specialists' fees, local field trips, and other resources. Setting up a financial account through FACTS (including paying the FACTS annual fee) are required for all students regardless of the intent to use a scholarship. In the event a refund is due based on the scholarship award, an adjustment will be made at the end of the school year. A thirty-day email notice is required to withdraw a student. All payments up to and including the 30 days of notice of withdrawal are forfeited PLUS 15% balance of contract applies. The tuition for the 30 days plus the 15% balance of contract cannot be paid with scholarship dollars.
