## **Digging Deeper**

Read aloud 1 Corinthians 11:23-26.

- 1. At the "Last Supper" what is the significance of Jesus asking his disciples to honor him with the bread and cup? (See also John 6:27, 30-35. Extra credit: If you have time, read John 6:41-69 for help with your answer.)
- 2. <u>Twice Jesus says, "...do this in remembrance of me." Why are we to continue doing this?</u>
- 3. Read 1 Corinthians 11:20-22. What's going on here that is a problem?
- 4. Read 1 Corinthians 11:27-30.
  - a. What does it mean to eat the bread and take the cup "in an unworthy manner?"
  - b. <u>Vs. 30 offers a cause as to why people are "weak, ill and dying." What does this mean?</u>
  - c. In vs. 28 it says "examine yourselves." How do we do that?
- 5. Were there any meaningful moments for you in the communion moment on Sunday? Were there other parts of the gathering that were meaningful to you?

## Making It Personal

- If you were leading someone or a group through communion, how would you go about it?
- What happens in your heart or goes through your mind when you take communion?
- Have you ever taken
  - communion in an "unworthy manner"? (side note: no worries. There's grace for that too). It's simply important to be mindful.
