## DIGGING DEEPER

**Let's dive into one specific passage! For this week we'll look at John 4:3-30.**

**Starter Questions:**

- Who was John? Why do you think he took the time to write his Gospel?
- Of the 5 basic genres of the Bible (Narrative, Poetry, Prophecy, Letters, Apocalypse) which one do you think best fits the Gospel of John?
- Let's look at the context of this passage. What is leading up to it? What happens afterward?

**Read John 4:3-30**

- What is the thought that stands out to you the most?
- If you're using a Study Bible, are there any study notes that stand out to you in these verses?
- Where do you see God's nature and character in this passage?
- How does Jesus balance accepting and correcting the woman at the well?

## MAKING IT PERSONAL

**It's not enough to just learn, we need to apply God's word to our everyday lives!**

- What is one practical way that you can share the love of God with someone this week?
- The Samaritan woman was rejected by society for many reasons. What is a way that you can refuse to reject others for these reasons?
